+ Event Set Up/Tear Down: facilitates the experience by setting up before events and taking down after events.

+ Love This City: involved in community outreach and events. We partner with different organizations to serve our city and world.

Life City Statement of Faith: building the church on a strong foundation +The Bible:

The Bible is the inspired, infallible Word of God. It is true in all that it teaches. As the flawless Word of God, it is our only authority for what we believe and how we live. *2 Timothy 3:16*

+ God:

We believe in one God who is the creator and sustainer of all things. He has manifested Himself to mankind as the Father in creation, the Son in redemption, and as the Holy Spirit (indwelling Spirit). Jesus is the "visible image of the invisible God." *Deuteronomy 6:4, 1 Timothy 3:16*

+ Sin and Salvation:

We believe that because of the original sin of Adam and Eve, all of humanity is in a fallen state and in need of salvation. Salvation comes by grace through faith based on the atoning sacrifice of Jesus Christ, which is His death, burial and resurrection. *Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, Ephesians 2:8-9*

+ The Gospel and Conversion:

The Gospel is the good news that Jesus died for our sins, was buried and rose again. We express our belief in the gospel through our obedience to the gospel. We obey the gospel and apply it to our lives by repenting of our sins (death to sin), being baptized in water in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of our sins (burial) and receiving the gift of the Holy Spirit (resurrection). + Christian Living:

We learn from scripture that God has always required a people who have been set-apart for Himself. As Christians we are to love God and love others. We are to worship God joyfully and seek to live a life that is pleasing to Him-in our thoughts, words and actions. We are empowered to live a life pleasing to God through the Holy Spirit.
